Package 6: Pipeline Cathodic Protection

Kalium Lakes Limited are requesting expression of interest to be involved as part of the installation of a 79.3 km DN100 x 4.8 mm steel gas pipeline located approximately 160 km south east of Newman, Western Australia. The scope of the package for **pipeline cathodic protection** is to include:

- Pipeline cathodic protection design, including impressed current system, temporary CP, test points;
- Site survey require to complete the design;
- Supply of test points and temporary CP equipment, including cabling;
- Inspection of installation for test points and temporary CP as installed by Construction Contractor;
- Supply and installation of impressed current CP system and monolithic CP equipment, to be located at both ends of the pipeline;
- Commissioning of CP system;
- Direct current voltage gradient testing of pipeline.

Works will need be completed to Company specifications and safety requirements and conditions set out by the pipeline license.

The Company plans to issue a formal request for pricing during the week commencing 17 December, with closure of submissions scheduled for early 2019. To be considered for invitation to provide a proposal on this package, please advise your expression of interest by providing the following information:

- 1. Company name, company ABN, contact person's name, email and phone number;
- 2. Proposed methodology of completing the works;
- 3. Capability statement, including equipment to be used (currently in possession or needs to be procured/hired), direct labour, subcontractors;
- 4. Previous similar experience;
- 5. Current accreditations including the Work, Health and Safety (WHS) accreditation;
- 6. Company's current indigenous relationships and proposed involvement in the contract execution;
- 7. Company's financial statement.
